Enclosed with this memo is a flyer providing important information about a feature program at this year's National Scout Jamboree: The Mysterium Compass. Please read and convey the information on this flyer to your troop Scoutmaster(s). This adventure is a <u>ticketed</u> event and only those Scouts with tickets for their <u>pre-assigned time</u> will be admitted. Mysterium Compass performances will begin on the first day of the jamboree, Monday, July 26. All tickets will be distributed in advance and will be placed in each troop's registration packet, which they will receive when they arrive at the jamboree. There are no extra tickets for any time. If a Scout misses his scheduled performance, he will have missed his chance to participate (or he will have to wait in a standby line).

In addition to the Mysterium Compass, the Scouting Century Foundation is sponsoring a special place called the Vault: 1,400 air-conditioned square feet of valuable treasures that honor 100 years of the Boy Scouts of America. The Vault is at the entry of The Mysterium Compass and will operate daily. It is open to all jamboree participants, youth and adults, as well as to the general public. No ticket is required.
